

Clarification on result for Notification No: 10/99 – Recruitment for Group – 2 Services

The following clarification is provided on the queries raised about willingness for joining a post. As per erstwhile Rule 7 of Rules of procedure of APPSC, which is applicable to the recruitment under consideration, enquiry needs to be conducted about relinquishment from a candidate. However, as understood, some of the candidates to whom posts were not allotted in earlier spells of the recruitment under Notification No: 10/99 have sought employment elsewhere, few of them are no more and some of them may not be interested in joining. As many of such candidates are not available, they cannot give letters of relinquishment. Therefore, letter of willingness is sought. Communication to the Secretary, APPSC on a plain paper informing that a candidate is willing to join the allotted post would be treated as the form prescribed for this purpose under Rule 7.

With regard to candidates who have declined earlier to join after allotment, such posts would be carried forward to next recruitment as per Rule 6 of Rules of Procedure of APPSS and there is no need for fresh consent as they have already relinquished their posts. No post would be allotted to such candidates as well as to the candidates who have joined in earlier spells and resigned thereafter in the final list which would be prepared after completion of enquiry (if any such names are included in the list published on 23/12/2016). With regard to candidates who have already joined in a post or resigned thereafter or declined post when offered in earlier spells, there is no question of seeking willingness or relinquishment because he/she has already joined Government Service or declined to join on earlier occasion.

All the candidates may note the above clarification and take appropriate action, wherever necessary.
